Adobe Connect for beginners: If this is the first time you are using the Adobe Connect online meeting tool, please take the time to read these instructions before the meeting starts:

- Adobe Connect only requires an internet connection, a web browser and Adobe Flash player version 10.1 or greater.
- Before attending the meeting, it is recommended that you test your computer by going to http://admin.adobeconnect.com/common/help/en/support/meeting_test.htm (the 4th step to the Connection test is for the Adobe Connect Add-in, please make sure this is properly installed).
- If the test is successful, you can now access the meeting: please click on [this link](#) and join as a Guest by typing your <FIRST NAME> and <COUNTRY>.
- The meeting will launch in your browser. If the meeting host has not yet arrived to the meeting, or meeting security requires the host to approve your attendance, you will be placed in a virtual “waiting room”. Once the meeting host accepts you into the meeting, the meeting room interface appears.
- The microphone will only be made available for the host and presenters, so you will only be able to ask questions via the typed chat function. If you have several questions, please number them and mention to which of the speakers you address each question.
- The webinar will be recorded and the recording uploaded to the Learn section of the Youth area. By attending, you agree to having your contribution recorded and made available internally for other young people to be able to benefit from the discussions.
